EDITORS CORNER

Vegetable Pasta Bake

Ingredients

1 dessertspoon of vegetable oil
1 onion chopped
1 green pepper sliced
8 mushrooms sliced
1 tin tomatoes
2 dessertspoons tomato sauce
1 or 2 cloves of garlic
mixed herbs
pepper
200g pasta
575ml cheese sauce
3 dessertspoons wholemeal bread-crumbs

Method

- Pre-heat the oven to 200°C / 400°F / Gas Mark 6.
- Heat the oil, fry the onion, pepper, mushrooms and crushed garlic for 5 minutes.
- Add the tomatoes, tomato sauce, mixed herbs and a little pepper.
- Bring to the boil, reduce heat and simmer for 20 minutes.
- Cook the pasta in boiling water for 12-15 minutes until it is soft. Drain the pasta and add to the vegetable mix.
- Stir and cook gently for 2-3 minutes.
- Put the pasta and vegetable mix into a casserole dish and cover with a thick cheese sauce (see page 26).
- Sprinkle with grated cheese and breadcrumbs.

Last Saturday at Morton Stadium, Santry Co Dublin, Niamh Foley and Sophie Meredith took on the top u17 schools girls in the 32 counties. Niamh ran the 100m in a time of 12.34 seconds and 200m sprint 25.55 seconds. She took the bronze medal in the 200m and just missed out on a medal in a blanket finish in the 100m. Sophie Meredith leaped 5.78m in the Long Jump and her efforts secured the silver medal, she returned later in the day to take on the Triple Jump and with a leap of 11.11m was crowned the Tailteann Games Champion.
